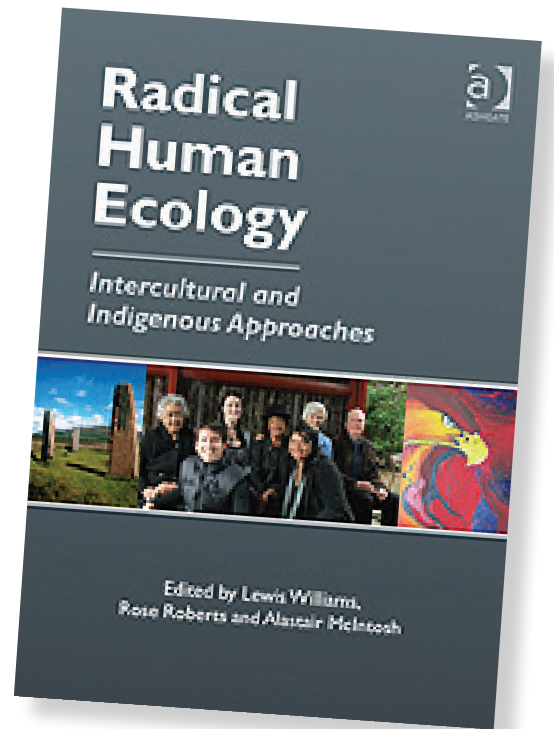

A member of the Cariboo Clan and a citizen of the Carrier Nation in north central British Columbia, Paul has a strong interest in collective efforts to address the health of land and peoples.

**Nikki Sanchez-Hood** is a graduate of from the University of Victoria with a double major in Environmental Studies and Social Justice. As a person of Indigenous and European descent, her life's passion centres around drawing knowledge from both worlds to create innovative solutions for humanity to live reciprocally with nature

**Dr Rose Roberts** is a Woodland Cree woman from the Lac La Ronge Indian Band in northern Saskatchewan. She was raised in her traditional territory amidst the influences of residential school. She has spent the majority of her worklife in the urban and academic setting but always operating from a perspective of walking in both worlds.

**Dr Lewis Williams** is a Ngai Te Rangi (maori) woman and Associate Professor, Health, University of Southern Queensland, Australia. She is the lead author of Radical Human Ecology, Founding Director of Koru International Network (KIN); her work in Aotearoa, Canada and Australia focuses on indigenous and intercultural approaches to healing our earth community.
